Admissions Policy

Looked after children will be given first priority ahead of all other applicants.

Children living in the area served by the school at the normal time of admission will be allocated a place at the school providing an application is received by the closing date. In the event of over-subscription any remaining places will be allocated using the following criteria in the order given:

1. children with a **sibling**† attending the school;
2. remaining applications.

In the event of over-subscription within either of the above criteria, priority will be given to looked after children and then be determined by straight line distance from home to school, those living closest being given highest priority. Exceptional medical circumstances (supported by medical evidence) may override the above. Please note that there is no guarantee of a place for pupils moving into the area served by the school after the published closing date for applications.

† A **sibling** is a child who has a brother, sister, stepbrother or stepsister living in the same family unit in the same family household and address who attends the preferred school in any year group excluding the final year.

Biological siblings who attend the preferred school in any yeargroup excluding the final year will also be treated as siblings irrespective of place of residence.

Children residing in the same household as part of an extended family, such as cousins, **will not** be treated as siblings.
